Notes on Finals Week:

- a. Students need not take more than two (2) finals in one day. If the student has three finals on Thursday, he/she may make arrangements with the teacher to take a final on Wednesday or Friday.
- b. Students are required to be in school only when they are taking their finals. Students must stay in their finals room for a minimum of one hour. After an hour, if finished, students may leave the classroom and campus. Students not finished after one hour may stay another fifteen minutes to finish.

◆ **Testing**

- The SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) is America's most widely accepted college entrance exam. It assesses high school students' general educational development and their ability to complete college-level work.

The SAT is part of the MME (Michigan Merit Exam), so all juniors will take it at Unity on April 10.

Many juniors will take the SAT on March 10 in preparation for the April test. The deadline for registration for the March 10 SAT is February 9.

Juniors who plan to take the SAT prep class at Unity (more information to come) should not sign up for the March SAT. The SAT prep class includes two SAT practice tests and test-taking strategies.

ACT Testing – Although Unity students will take the SAT as part of the Michigan Merit Exam, the ACT is still an option for college acceptance and scholarship purposes.

- The PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary Scholastic Achievement Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) was given to 150 juniors and sophomores on October 11. Counselors will be reviewing the results with students in December.
- Please keep the students in your prayers as they make decisions concerning future coursework, college choices, and career options. Pray that each student may sense, hear, and follow God’s plan for their lives.

- ◆ **College representatives** regularly visit Unity. Students can sign up to meet with them. These college representatives provide good college information as well as information specific to their school. The college representatives at Unity are announced in the Student Bulletin.
- ◆ **Beware of ACT/SAT Study Help Scams and Student Recognition.**
 - Unity parents have received calls from 1-800-SERVICE type numbers. The caller says something like, “Your son/daughter has requested study helps...” They want your order and credit card number. Parents beware!

PSAT/SAT, and ACT tests and study helps are available from our counselors.

Unity will again offer an SAT prep class for juniors. An informational letter will be sent home in December to junior parents giving more information. SAT prep classes will be held on Saturday mornings in February and March.

- **Student Recognition:** We occasionally receive questions about contests designed to select an outstanding student and about programs that seek to recognize outstanding students through a listing in a publication.

The National Association of Secondary School Principals (NASSP) concludes that, “most programs of either type are commercial in nature; the primary purpose is to enrich the sponsor at the expense of students or their parents.” The NASSP, therefore, **“advises against nominating students either for pageants or for listing in award publications.”**
