5. **WINTERFEST:** The two weeks of Winterfest creates community among students and staff. These two weeks include crazy dress-up days and competitions between classes. Many staff are involved in the dress-up days as well as the games which creates another element of community building. On Friday, February 9, the final day of Winterfest, each class participates in the culminating event – the lip sync. For one hour, students and staff come together celebrating the two weeks of fun and school spirit by cheering each other on during the lip sync. All lip syncs are taped and posted to YouTube at the conclusion for parents to view. This day is meant for the students and staff at Unity, but if parents want to attend, we ask that you arrive at school by 11:45 a.m. to check in. At 12:00 noon, the doors of the school will be locked as all staff and students attend the lip sync. Thank you.
