There will be NO Hudsonville Public busing on Wednesday, November 21. Students must provide their own transportation to school. In the afternoon after Grandparents Day, Unity Bus #03 will provide transportation home to students who ride south & east of school; Bus #04 for students who ride north and west of school.

Notes on Finals Week:

- Students need not take more than two (2) finals in one day. If the student has three finals on Thursday, he/she may make arrangements with the teacher to take a final on Wednesday or Friday.
- Students are required to be in school only when they are taking their finals. Students must stay in their finals room for a minimum of one hour. After an hour, if finished, students may leave the classroom and campus. Students not finished after one hour may stay another fifteen minutes to finish.
- Buses will make their morning pick-up run as normal and will leave Unity as noted in the schedule above.

◆ **Testing**

- The SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) is America’s most widely accepted college entrance exam. It assesses high school students’ general educational development and their ability to complete college-level work.

The SAT is part of the MME (Michigan Merit Exam), so all juniors will take it at Unity on April 9.

Many juniors will take the SAT on March 9 in preparation for the April test. The deadline for registration for the March 9 SAT is February 8.

Unity will offer a five session SAT Prep class to juniors on Saturdays in February and March. We will need a minimum of 25 students to run the class. Details will be mailed home in December.

ACT Testing – Although Unity students will take the SAT as part of the Michigan Merit Exam, the ACT is still an option for college acceptance and scholarship purposes.

- The PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary Scholastic Achievement Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) was given to 158 juniors and sophomores on October 10. Counselors will be reviewing the results with students in December.
- Please keep the students in your prayers as they make decisions concerning future coursework, college choices, and career options. Pray that each student may sense, hear, and follow God’s plan for their lives.

Important dates:

November	College applications should be submitted by Thanksgiving.
March 1	Financial Aid Forms (FAFSA) filing deadline. FAFSA is now available to file online. The sooner the FAFSA is filed, the sooner students will receive financial aid packages from the colleges they have been admitted to.

- ◆ College Scholarship information is provided to students through the Student Bulletin. As our counselors receive information, they will publish it in the Student Bulletin. The Student Bulletin is read each day at the beginning of 4th period, is posted on bulletin boards throughout school, and it is posted on Unity’s website <unitychristian.org> (Click on “News & Events” and then “Student Bulletin”).

◆ **College representatives** regularly visit Unity. Students can sign up to meet with them. These college representatives provide good college information as well as information specific to their school. The college representatives at Unity are announced in the Student Bulletin.

◆ **Beware of ACT/SAT Study Help Scams and Student Recognition.**

- Unity parents have received calls from 1-800-SERVICE type numbers. The caller says something like, “Your son/daughter has requested study helps...” They want your order and credit card number. Parents beware!

PSAT/SAT, and ACT tests and study helps are available from our counselors.

Unity will again offer an SAT prep class for juniors. An informational letter will be sent home in December to junior parents giving more information. SAT prep classes will be held on Saturday mornings in February and March.

- **Student Recognition:** We occasionally receive questions about contests designed to select an outstanding student and about programs that seek to recognize outstanding students through a listing in a publication.

The National Association of Secondary School Principals (NASSP) concludes that, “most programs of either type are commercial in nature; the primary purpose is to enrich the sponsor at the expense of students or their parents.” The NASSP, therefore, **“advises against nominating students either for pageants or for listing in award publications.”**

16. **COACHING OPPORTUNITY:**

Unity Christian has an opening for an **Assistant Varsity Softball Coach**. 17. **CRU CARDS:** If your son or daughter is planning to try out for a winter sport, he/she must have a CRU Card prior to trying out each season. CRU Cards are given out by the athletic office and are a way for us to track all the necessary paperwork prior to the start of the season. Below is a list of requirements that must be completed for student athletes to receive a CRU Card. CRU Cards are required by the coaches the first day of tryouts/practice for athletes to participate.

- Physical dated after April 15, 2018 turned in to the athletic office (physical forms are available by clicking [here](#)).
- ImPACT Baseline Concussion Testing complete – To be done every other year. Athletes in all winter sports EXCEPT bowling need to have an up to date ImPACT test.
- Academic Eligibility & Transfer Eligibility – To be completed by the athletic office.
- Register and complete the required “FinalForms” paperwork. This includes medical information, travel permission, and athletic handbooks. Access our site by clicking here: <https://unitychristian-mi.finalforms.com>. **If your son or daughter participated in a fall sport and they plan on a winter sport, please log into FinalForms to make sure information is updated and they are marked down as trying out for a winter sport. Your student must log in separately to FinalForms with the email that you use for them. Please make sure you have your student’s correct email address to make sure that they get the invitation to sign in to read and sign the commitment form.**
- Once the requirements are met, athletes can stop in the Athletic Office to pick up their CRU Card during break or lunch.

Insurance -- Unity requires that all athletes have primary insurance. Unity offers secondary insurance. Students whose family does not have insurance or has “My Child” insurance must contact the Athletic Director (jengbers@unitychristian.org) who will provide information about temporary insurance during the athlete’s sport season.

Remember – if your son or daughter is planning to try out for a winter sport and has not yet turned in a physical to the office dated after April 15, 2018, he/she must do so in order to participate in practice or tryouts.
