1. **NEW STUDENT SERVICES/FRONT DESK RECEPTIONIST:** Unity welcomes Jennifer Byker as our student services/front desk receptionist. Jennifer is not new to our school as all three of her children attended Unity (Kelsey – '12 grad, Casey – '15 grad, Marley – sr.) and she has also been a volunteer in our food court. Jen is very excited to be joining Unity and is thankful she can work with people in a Christian community.
2. **SCHOOL CALENDAR 2019-20:** Included at the end of this bulletin is the 2019/20 school calendar.
3. **LATE START:** There will be a late start on Wednesday, February 20. For all students riding a bus, the bus schedule will remain the same and you will arrive to school at your normal scheduled time. For students who drive or arrive other than a bus, school will begin at 8:25 a.m. (first bell rings at 8:20 a.m.).
4. **NEW STUDENT NIGHTS AT UNITY:** During three nights in January, Unity students and staff hosted 153 students and their parents for an orientation to Unity. The night consisted of a tour of the building with brief descriptions of what students will experience and learn, a time where counselors explained the curriculum and course selections, and at the end of the evening, students were able to pick up a Unity Christian t-shirt.

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6. **WINTERFEST:** The two weeks of Winterfest creates community among students and staff. These two weeks include crazy dress-up days and competitions between classes. Many staff are involved in the dress-up days as well as the games which creates another element of community building.

With school being closed due to the winter weather the week of January 28, we had to make changes to the Winterfest schedule. Winterfest began Monday, February 4, and will run through Friday, February 15. Please note the updated details below:

- Friday, February 8, will now be a full day of school for students.
- Lip syncs will now be held on Thursday, February 14, during the school day. All lip syncs will be taped and posted to YouTube for parents to view. This day is meant for the students and staff at Unity, but if parents want to attend we ask that you arrive at school by 1:15 p.m. to check in. At 1:25, the doors of school will be locked as all staff and students attend the lip sync.
- Friday, February 15, will be a full day of school. Winterfest festivities will be held in the evening when our varsity basketball teams play Zeeland East. The recognition of our Winterfest hosts and hostesses will take place at the end of the girls' game.
- The Winterfest dance that was scheduled for February 8 will now be held on Friday, February 15.

7. **ADVANCED NOTICE – STATE TESTING:** Tuesday, April 9, is a state testing date where students in grades 9-11 will be taking state standardized tests at Unity. All senior students will not attend school on this date. All juniors will continue testing on Wednesday, April 10. More details will be provided as we move closer to this date.

8. **2019-2020 TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM:** For the coming 2019-2020 school year, Unity will be continuing to utilize FACTS, an online web-based application program.

- ◆ All parents requesting tuition assistance are required to participate in the FACTS program to receive Unity tuition assistance. The FACTS application must be completed by the **March 31, 2019, deadline.** Confirming documents can be submitted later.
