1. **OPEN HOUSE: Monday, September 9, 7:00 p.m.**

The open house will begin with an introduction of *The Infusion Project*. This initiative, created by Unity Christian, is an exciting opportunity, allowing us to better serve parents, students, and the larger Unity community.

At Unity, we believe it is more challenging than ever for students to navigate through the issues they face during their teenage years.

This 30-minute presentation will describe how Unity is cultivating awareness and understanding for our community to best engage a rapidly changing culture while living in faith, with excellence, for lives of service. Included in the presentation will be the introduction of:

- How Unity addresses with its students specific issues related to the high school years.
- A new blog attached to Unity’s website giving parents information and help related to topics impacting students.
- Parent Nights! Two evenings during the school year for parents to come to Unity to learn about and discuss relevant topics related to students, their world, and their faith.
- Access to faith-based resources for parents and students related to engaging culture.
- An inside look into chapels at Unity.

Unity Principal Jerry DeGroot and Director for Spiritual Life Dan Landstra will lead this presentation. We are excited to introduce *The Infusion Project* to the Unity community and look forward to the impact it will have as we claim all things for Christ.

After the presentation, parents will meet with their student’s teachers in the following three classes: 1st, 4th, and 8th periods. All Careerline Technical Center student parents will meet with the Dean of Students Scott Soodsma during 8th period in the counseling center, Rm. 113.

This is a special evening for parents! We ask all our parents to attend this important evening to learn more about Unity and how together we help our young people grow and develop. We hope to see you on Monday, September 9, at 7:00 p.m.

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2. **ACTIVITY TEAMS:** There is a new opportunity for the students at Unity to serve their peers. We now have activity teams replacing what used to be class officers. This change will allow students to take more elective courses while still being involved in organizing class activities. There will be three different teams per class: food court, activity, and Winterfest. The food court team will help serve food at lunch time once a week. The activities team will plan and organize a class event where students have fun and socialize together. The Winterfest team will help organize their class for the events during spirit week and the lip sync. These class teams will be supervised by a team of three teachers and have meetings throughout the year. We are excited to see how our students can work together to make the 2019-2020 a great school year.

3. **LATE START:** Wednesday, October 2, will be our first late start. For all students riding a bus, the bus schedule will remain the same and you will arrive early (normal bus schedule time). For students who drive or arrive other than a bus, school will begin at 8:25 a.m. (first bell rings at 8:20 a.m.).

4. **URGENT NEED - HOSTING AN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT:** Hosting an International student is a wonderful opportunity for your family to experience and learn about a new culture while providing a home and family for a student who desires attend high school in the U.S. A safe and loving home is key to their success as they learn and discover who God has created them to be.

Partners In Learning has a hosting opportunity at Unity Christian for the 2019-2020 school year. International students come with their own spending money and health insurance. A \$700 monthly stipend is provided to host families to help offset any costs that are incurred while hosting. A host family is needed for George, a 10th grade boy returning from China who enjoys biking, bowling, reading, photography, and enjoys using technology to solve problems. He describes himself as polite, optimistic, and friendly with a good sense of humor.

5. **STUDENT HANDBOOK:** The Student Handbook is posted on our website under the “Academics” tab or by clicking [here](#).

6. **EXCUSING STUDENTS:** Unity requires a written note or telephone request from a parent/guardian to give your student permission to sign out. When your student returns, he/she must stop at the office and sign in. We do not accept absences by email.

7. **UNITY’S STUDENT BULLETIN** is made available in classrooms during 4th period. Parents can view the Student Bulletin each day online on Unity’s website www.unitychristian.org under the “News and Events” tab.

8. **FOOD COURT:** Unity has gone “cashless” in the food court during the school day. Instructions on how to set up your student’s account was mailed home along with the PIN number your student will need to use in order to buy food.

You may place funds in your student’s account via credit card or bank account transfer. There is a charge of \$2.65 per \$100 for credit card transactions; \$1.00 per \$100 for direct bank transfers. The funds should be available within 20 minutes for an online transaction. You may also bring funds directly to the Unity office with no fee; however, the funds will not be available for 24 hours. When bringing money to the office, please place money in an envelope with your student’s name on it.

- ◆ **SAT TEST DATES** for this fall are October 5 (with registration by September 6), November 2 (with registration by October 3), and December 7 (with registration by November 8). **Seniors**, see your counselor regarding the value of retaking the SAT or possibly the ACT in your situation.

- ◆ **ACT TEST DATES:** **Seniors**, the fall ACT test date is October 26. Registration for this test needs to be completed online by September 20. (Late registration deadline is October 4. Late registrants are charged extra.)

The winter ACT test is December 14, with a November 8 registration deadline. Registration is all online.

- ◆ **PSAT TEST DATE:** Unity will be giving the PSAT (Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test) to **interested juniors** on the morning of October 16. All juniors are encouraged to take this test. Sophomores are invited to take this as space allows.

The PSAT is also the qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship.

The fee for this test is \$17.00. Students will receive further information about signing up for the PSAT later this month.

- ◆ **COLLEGE APPLICATIONS:** On Thursday, August 30, counselors met with seniors in their Global Studies to review all the steps in the **college application process**, including filling out the Common Application. Students also signed in to their Naviance Student Accounts, which is the program used to send transcripts and other college documents.

◆ **FINANCIAL AID AND PARENT COLLEGE INFORMATION NIGHT:**

Financial Aid Meeting: On Tuesday, September 24, at 7:00 p.m., a college financial aid counselor will be here to walk parents through the college financial aid process including any changes to the FAFSA. This meeting will take place in the lower commons area.

College Information Night: Is your oldest child a senior this year? Is he/she beginning to look at colleges? Are you wondering, "How in the world does this whole process work?" If so, this night is just for you. Counselors will have met with seniors and already shared this information with them. We will cover the college application process, how we send transcripts, and scholarship search programs. We will meet Tuesday night, September 24, at 8:00 p.m., in the lower commons area immediately following the financial aid meeting. Contact a Unity counselor if you have any questions.

Parents may attend either meeting or both.

◆ **FRESHMAN:** Counselors will be meeting with freshman classes to introduce themselves and talk about the role of the high school guidance counselor at Unity.

◆ Last spring, current freshmen, sophomores, and juniors took the PSAT 8, PSAT 9, or PSAT 10. Early in September, counselors will be handing back and explaining these test scores.

16. **UNITY ALL SEASONS-ALL SPORTS PASSES:** Unity sports passes can be purchased in the office.

- You can buy a Family Pass for \$125. This means that dad and mom and all dependent members of the family will receive a pass that will gain them admission to all Unity home athletic events in the fall, winter, and spring.
- Also available are the individual adult season pass for \$50, and the individual student pass, grades K-12, for \$20.
- Admission at the gate for all Unity sporting events is \$5 per person.
